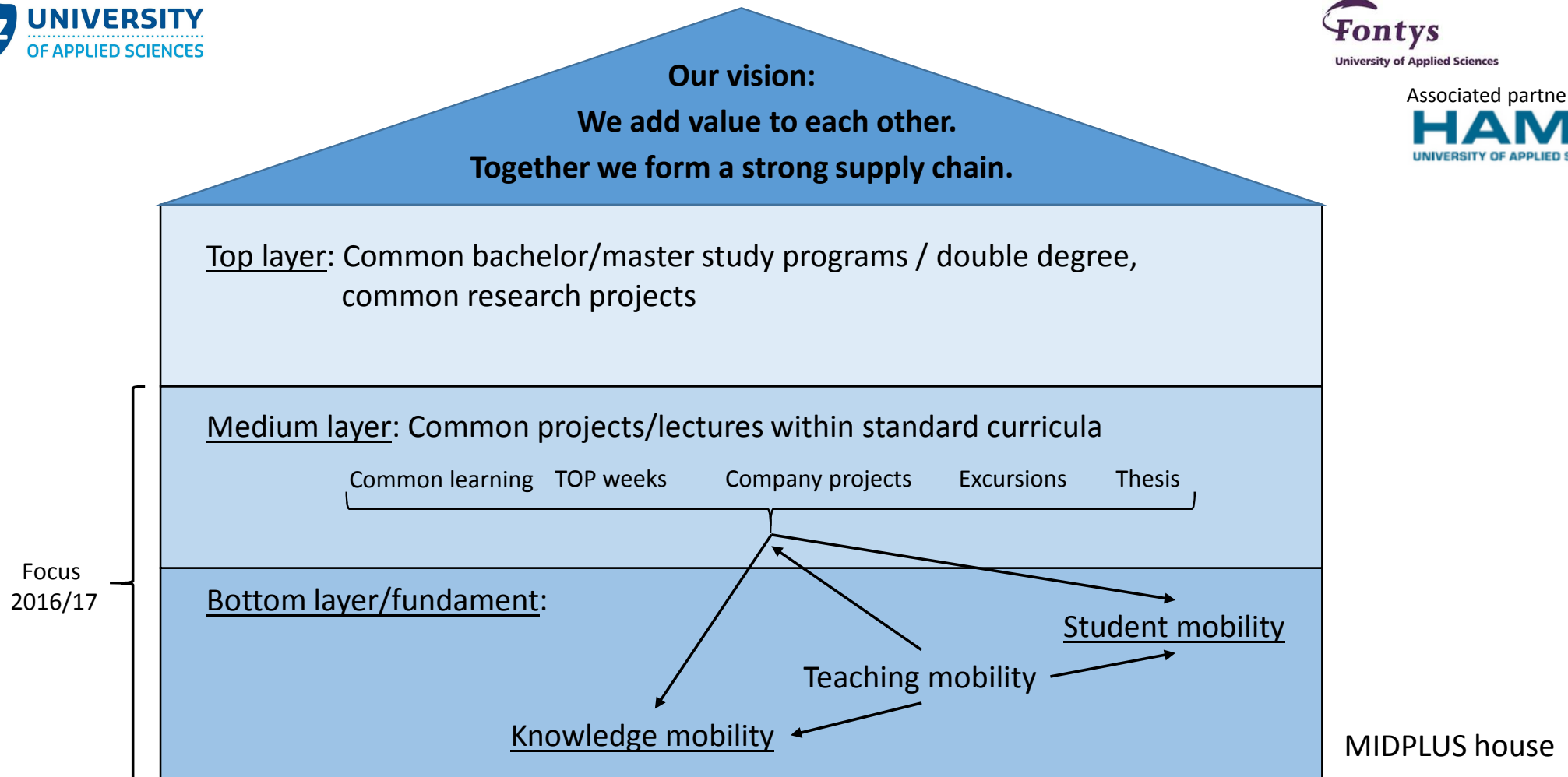

## The logistics cluster

- Our mission:**
- We define core competences of all partners. The partners share their knowledge to gain a strong knowledge pool of supply chain management („knowledge mobility“)
  - We want to achieve a steady and sustainable „student mobility“
  - We want our students to understand the power of a European mindset and gain knowledge how to work in international teams
  - We focus on common projects within the given curricula and given capacities
  - We follow a strict time to market philosophy

## MIDPLUS

### The logistics cluster

- **Common learning:** All partners share guest lectures and internal lectures. [knowledge mobility]
- **TOP weeks: (one topic, one week):** All partner institutions stand for specific core competences. In a TOPweek students of all partners have got the chance to attend a block course of about a week at a partner university to benefit from these competences. The course is merited at all partner universities (i.e. elective subject). The TOPweek will include cultural topics to stimulate the conversation between the students and to get to know country and culture. [knowledge mobility, student mobility]
- **Company projects:** Real company projects are worked on with mixed teams of students of the partner universities. The main goal is to teach students how to organize international projects (one part on-site, one part via telecommunication), how to cope with different types of approach (working culture of different nations/universities) and how to use the different core competences of partner universities and their students and lecturers [knowledge mobility, student mobility]

## MIDPLUS

### The logistics cluster

- **Excursions:** The partner universities will organize their excursions in a common week once a year. The students of all partner universities can attend any of the excursions. The programs of all excursions are published at all partner universities. [student mobility]
- **Thesis:** Either one student works on a thesis topic in the country/region of a partner university (if applicable in cooperation with a company; merited by home institution of the student, additional supervision by partner university) or a team of students of different partner universities work together on a common topic. [student mobility]
- **Teaching Mobility:** corresponding to Erasmus+ [knowledge mobility]
